

The Weipa Community Flow Chart

A guide for individuals working with people at risk of self harm and suicide

Questions to use to assess level of risk and to help decide where to refer

- *Is everything alright in your life?*
- *Is despair/hopelessness being expressed by the person?*
- *Is the person receiving treatment for mental illness/emotional problem?*
- *Is there abuse of drugs or alcohol?*

- *Is there a family history of suicide?*
- *Have there been past suicide attempts?*
- *Are they thinking about suicide?*
- *Have they a suicide plan?*
- *Do they have access to means (e.g. gun)?*
- *What protective factors do they have?*

Medium to High Risk

- * Multiple risk factors present (consider answers to the above questions)
- * Active suicidal thoughts present

Low Risk

Low Risk DOES NOT MEAN No Risk

Agreeable to a referral at next possible time
