

# The Northern Peninsula Area **Community Flow Chart**



A guide for individuals working with people at risk of self harm and suicide

## Questions to use to assess level of risk and to help decide where to refer

- Is everything alright in your life?
- Is despair/hopelessness being expressed
- by the person?
- Is the person receiving treatment for mental illness/emotional problem?
- Is there abuse of drugs or alcohol?

- Is there a family history of suicide?
- Have there been past suicide attempts?
- Are they thinking about suicide?
- Have they a suicide plan?
- Do they have access to means (e.g. gun)?
- What protective factors do they have?

## **Medium to High Risk**

- Multiple risk factors present (consider answers to the above questions)
- **Active suicidal thoughts present**

### **Low Risk**
